What is the *Dare to Imagine Fund*?

The *Dare to Imagine Fund* is the next level of the Bright Hope Baptist Church capital campaign. A capital campaign is comprised of projects and plans that SURPASS the budgeted amount to spend each year on the “normal expenses” of the ministry. This fund is generated from ADDITIONAL giving-sacrificial giving– that is above and beyond tithes and offerings.

How will God’s money be spent?

Year One – 2011

- Increase ministry outreach, especially to young families and adults
- Strengthen our church by developing programs and ministries that grow children, families, young adults, and adults.
- Install in sanctuary and chapel video screens and projectors to enhance worship experience, teach bible study, effectively and creatively evangelize to new believers, and better share with congregation how we carry out our vision and mission.
- Replace HVAC system (installed in 1965).
- Install new carpet in sanctuary.
- Repair roof and purchase pew cushions.
- Repave Marvine Street and fill potholes in church parking lot.

Year Two – 2012

- Retire church’s remaining **\$830,000** renovation mortgage! (*Loan commenced in 2002, and we have already repaid \$1.2 million of \$2 million loan*)

How much should I give?

You can give **\$11.53 a week**, **\$50.00 a month**, or **\$600.00 a year** for the next two years. This is a commitment of \$1,200 over two years.
